What does this vaccine protect against?

This vaccine provides increased protection against negative health effects that are caused by the COVID-19 virus.



COVID-19 vaccines are available in Alberta. Anyone 6 months of age or older (healthy, non-immunocompromised individuals) should get the COVID-19 vaccine.



Who should not get this vaccine?

You may not be able to get this vaccine if you have an allergy to any part of the vaccine or experience serious or unusual side effects after receiving this vaccine or one of its components.



What are the side effects of this vaccine?

The side effects tend to be mild and temporary and include redness/swelling/soreness at the injection site, crying, fatigue, irritability, fever, poor appetite, etc. Side effect symptoms can be managed by placing a cool, wet cloth on the injection site or by taking medications like ibuprofen or acetaminophen to deal with fever or pain.
