What is the TDM? The Therapeutics Decision-Making (TDM) Examination aims to assess the competence of candidates at the level required of a family physician practising independently and safely in Canada. The content is developed by the Medical Council of Canada (MCC), and the examination is administered by the MCC on behalf of the Practice-Ready Assessment (PRA) programs for use in the selection of candidates into PRA programs.

AIMGA's Study Group! This is a 33-hour course for those who have been deemed PRA eligible as a family medicine practitioner. AIMGA has a 95% pass rate for those who have been part of our TDM study group.

Meet our Moderator! Hira Waqar was born in Pakistan and moved to Canada in 2001. She completed her BSc in Biology from the University of Calgary. She then obtained an MD degree from the American University of Caribbean. She completed clinical rotations in hospitals in the United States and England. Following this, she completed her family medicine training in Pakistan and is now in practice as a licensed family physician after having successfully completed the PRA-AB assessment. She successfully passed the TDM and has supported AIMGA members to do the same. She is looking forward to working with those preparing for this exam.
